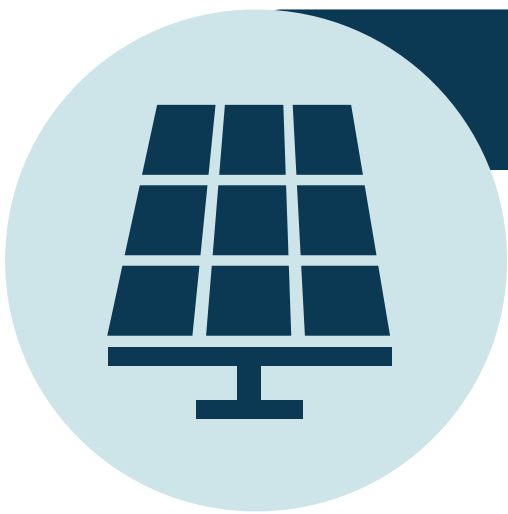

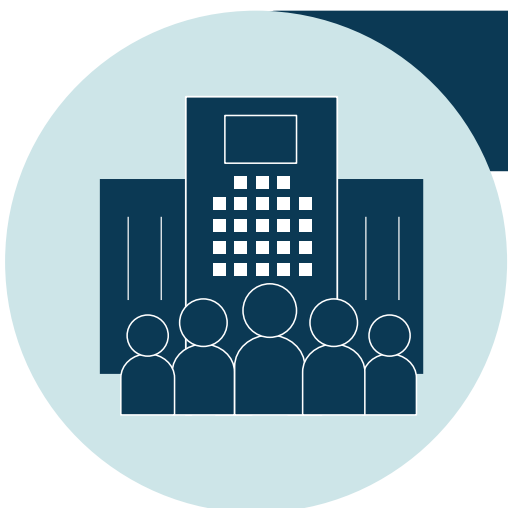

Our Modelling Graduate Programme has been designed to give you a holistic introduction to our energy modelling specialism. Joining as a Graduate Modeller, you will become a part of the global modelling team from day one. During the 16-month programme, you will spend most of your time deepening your knowledge and technical skills within the modelling team, as well as one 4-month placement within the Consultancy team to see how our models are applied in this context.

Modelling

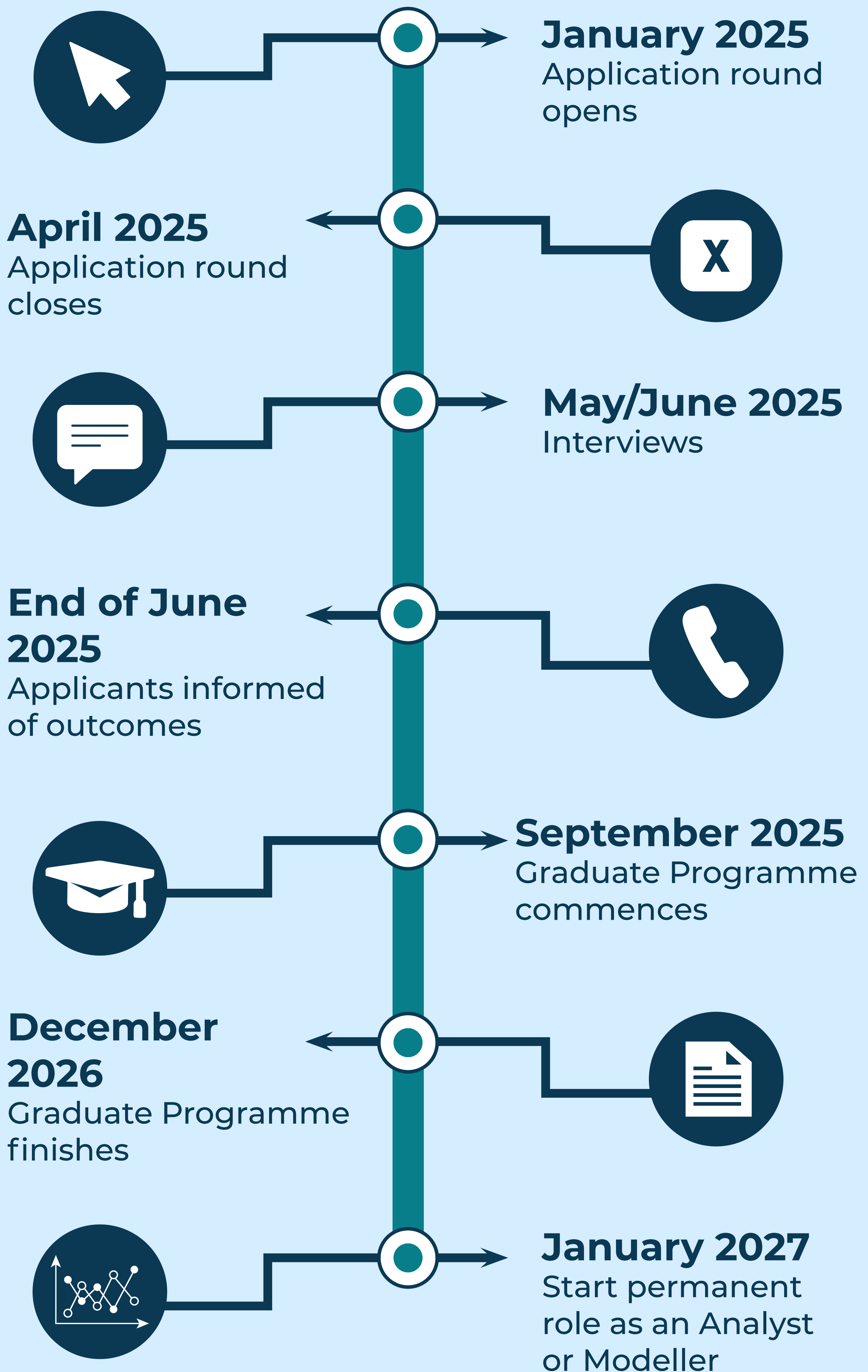

Submit your application today
